ON THE ROAD KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

1



Make sure to have a valid driver's license and vehicle registration, it's mandatory while you're in Baja California. Failure to comply can result in the vehicle being impounded and payment of a fine.

If you plan on driving, be sure that your insurance covers the legal minimum requirements of liability coverage into México, otherwise it's very important to purchase a Mexican auto insurance policy. A Mexican insurance policy can prevent hassles in case of an accident. Policies may be bought easily online or at various locations by the border.

Be aware that speed limits in México are in kilometers (1 mile=1.6 km). For example, the speed limit on highways is 55 miles per hour and within city limits is 25 miles per hour. While driving in México respect and obey traffic signs.

It's illegal to introduce and carry guns and ammo into México.

DRUGS are prohibited in México, even if you have a medical prescription for marijuana, it does not apply.

DO NOT drink and drive.

It is a traffic violation to use a cellular phone or mobile device while driving in the state of Baja California. Always use your seatbelt. "Click it or Ticket" applies in Baja California.

Along certain Mexican roads and highways you will find military checkpoints where you are subject to a routine search. Please cooperate, be patient and before you know it, you will be on your way.

In Baja we have 2 types of roads, toll and free, be sure to know where you are driving and to carry some cash with you, some of the toll booths do not accept credit/debit cards.

The city of Tijuana, Baja California enforces the ban of tinted windows in all motor vehicles, excluding those that have manufacturer's tinted windows. Law enforcement officers can stop any vehicle that doesn't comply with this regulation and request the owner/driver to remove the unauthorized tinted film on the scene. Failure to comply can result in the vehicle being impounded and payment of a fine.

Try not to drive at night/avoid, but if you do, whenever you stop overnight, remove bags and other valuables from the car and take them inside your room.

Place maps, travel brochures, and valuables in the glove compartment or trunk once you get to your destination. Carry wallets, checkbooks, and purses with you.

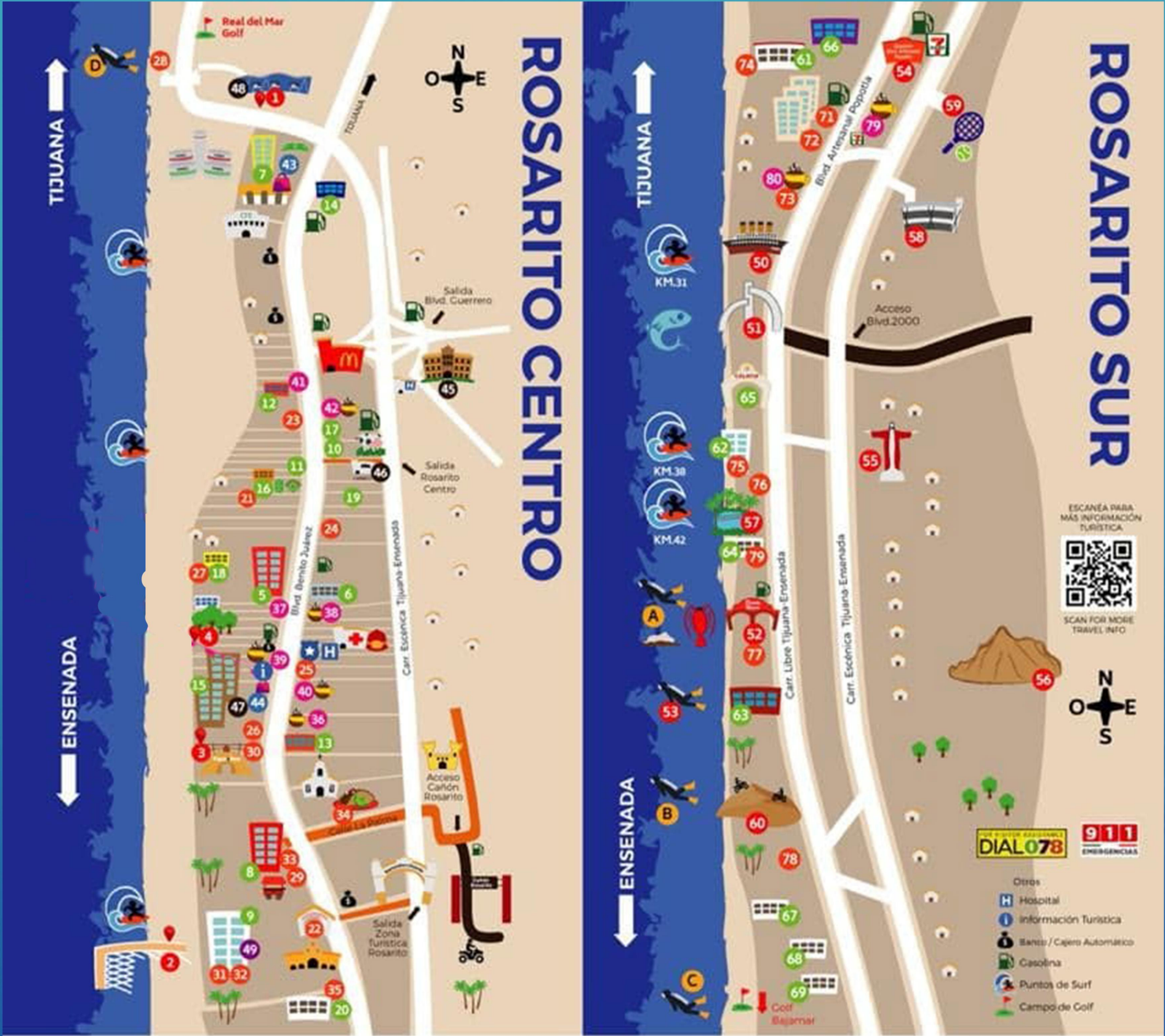
